Yahuah Kids Network was created with Code. You can learn a lot more about Coding, like CSS to add more style, and JavaScript for creating interactive websites. You can even explore the future with Cloud computing and Machine Learning, plus a bunch of other cool things!

Yahuah Kids Network is looking for you to create a web page and step into the role of an Engineer!

Let's talk about the basics of creating a web page, starting with what's found at the very top of all documents: **<!DOCTYPE html>**. This ensures that a browser adheres to the specifications as closely as it can. **HyperText Markup Language** `<html>` which is the foundation to a web page. The **<head>** section of an HTML document is the part that doesn't show up in the web browser when you load the page. It contains information such as the page **<title>**, which appears in the browser tab. The **<body>** contains the visible content of the web page, including the **<h1>** (Largest) to **<h6>** (Smallest) tags that help define HTML headings, text, paragraphs **<p>**, to make a line break **
, images **, and other elements.

Fun Fact: Closing tags have a backslash (**/**) before them, and tells the browser where an HTML element ends.
